

What is The Towcester Museum Project?

The Towcester Museum Trust is a registered charity founded in 2003 and dedicated to providing a quality museum & visitor centre for Towcester. Located in the courtyard of a former Georgian coaching inn in the heart of historic Towcester, the museum will provide a centre for tourism and historical information for the district and a much needed focal point for the exhibition, display and interpretation of the history of the Towcester district.

This heritage project will comprise:

- A series of modern museum galleries
- A tourist information and visitor centre
- A venue for temporary exhibitions
- A museum shop
- An educational & research facility
- A facility for preserving local historic archives & artefacts

Once complete the Towcester Museum Project will provide an important amenity and heritage asset that will greatly enhance commercial and community activity within the town.

Gift Aid - Notes for donors

Your payment to this Registered Charity can be treated as a Gift Aid donation. If you are a UK taxpayer, we can reclaim the tax paid on your donation at no extra cost to you,- This means that a further 25p in every £1 can be reclaimed by the Charity and put to good use by the Museum. You must pay an amount of income tax or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax the charity reclaims on your donations in the last or current tax year. (The tax reclaimed is currently 25p for each £1 you give).
